

- Do you want to return to the GPhC register?
- Are you finding it difficult to understand all the different components of the portfolio?
- Are you struggling to complete the portfolio?

We have developed this online course to help you understand the General Pharmaceutical Council requirements so that you can submit your portfolio of evidence for assessment. You will be supported by CPPE tutors throughout the course.

### What will I learn during the course?

This online course is structured over six weeks and will enable you to:

- reflect on the requirements for safe and effective practice as a pharmacy professional
- evaluate how any work experience, education or CPD has prepared you for practice
- assess your knowledge, skills and behaviours against the GPhC standards for pharmacy professionals
- identify gaps in your knowledge, skills and behaviours and prepare a personal development plan to address these
- compile a portfolio of evidence to support an application for registration.



### More about this course

Each week you will be given learning activities which may involve reading, accessing websites, working through the different parts of the portfolio, completing your personal reflective journal or joining discussion forums.

### When does the e-course run?

The tutor-supported course runs twice a year, starting in January and June, and is spread over six weeks. Please see the **CPPE website** for dates for the e-courses.

### Is there a charge?

The course is free but you will be expected to participate for the full six weeks, otherwise a non-attendance fee may be charged.
